Circulation parameters enforce your library's policies and practices within Sierra. Circulation parameters determine whether and how items circulate to patrons, the days and hours the library is open, how to fill holds, when and how much to fine patrons, and when to report delinquent patrons to a collection agency.

- Transferring ownership of items and collections among locations (optional products: Mobile, Floating, Deposit Collections)
